



Corbould Park, Caloundra – Stabling Project

Work has commenced on the civil component of the stabling project at Corbould Park. This will require amendments to the current protocols associated with use of this facility for training purposes.

The following alterations are to be implemented from Monday 27 July 2009.

- Track work hours – 4.00am to 8.00am.
- The trotting track is to be closed as it falls within the contractor's compound.
- Access to the swimming pond and bullring will be via the walkway adjacent to the outside running rail of the course proper from the 1800m to 1600m.
- Access to the swimming pond and bullring will be restricted to track work hours. (This will be reviewed as works progress and conditions change).

It is expected that the civil component of this project will take around 3 months, after which construction of the stables will commence. It is anticipated that the entire project will run through until March 2010.

As part of this project a bio-retention basin is being constructed near the swimming pond and this will necessitate amending the access point to the swimming compound. This work will be undertaken over the next few days and will see the signage and entrance gate placed on the opposite side of the compound.

Please find attached an updated stabling plan, which includes a map outlining the access point to the swimming pond and bullring.

Your assistance with the implementation of the above-mentioned alterations to facility use is appreciated. Please do not hesitate to contact the following representatives should you wish to discuss this issue. Fortnightly meetings will be held between the contractors, project manager's, Queensland Racing and the Sunshine Coast Turf Club. You will be kept abreast of any alterations to the conditions and any updates on the progress of the works.
